# Little Chute

## 2011 TERRACE TREE APPLICATION

The Village of Little Chute has budgeted money to plant trees on the terrace for any taxpayer that would like to purchase them. Your cost per terrace tree will be \$60, with the balance being paid with budgeted money. All applications are handled on a first-come, first-serve basis, as long as the budget money lasts. Village staff will plant the trees, which are balled & burlaped with a minimum of a 1.5" trunk diameter, starting in the fall as specified by the Village Forestry Manual. Property owners may specify a particular species of tree, but the final determination will be made by the Forestry Dept to avoid dangerous and costly maintenance of trees, and to assure the "right tree" is planted for the future. Property owners must have curb and gutter before they can have terrace trees. Following are the types of trees available.

<b>Trees For Normal Terraces Without Powerlines</b>			
Elm (hybrid)	60'	55'	Vase shaped tree, medium texture bright green leaves turn yellow in fall.
Hackberry	45'	35'	Broad round shaped tree, well balanced, medium texture 1" to 3" lustrous green leaves.
Honey Locust	60'	55'	Broad oval shaped tree, open, spreading, fine textured foliage, green leaves turn yellow.
Kentucky Coffee	65'	55'	Irregular oval shaped tree, texture medium when in leaf, coarse in winter.
Linden	60'	45'	Pyramid shaped tree, glossy heart shaped foliage, dense branching.
<b>Trees For Small Terraces &amp; Under Powerlines</b>			
Amur Maple / Tartarian	20'	15'	Huntergreen leaves in the summer, gold & red in the fall.
Autumn Blaze Pear	35'	15'	Narrow column shaped tree, medium texture glossy green leaves turn gold-red.
Aut. Brill. Serviceberry	20'	15'	Broad oval shaped tree, irregular medium-fine texture leaf.
Japanese Lilac	20'	15'	White flowers in spring.
Thornless Hawthorn	20'	20'	Round shaped tree, dense branches, medium fine texture 1" to 4" glossy green leaves.
Springsnow Crabapple	15'	15'	White blossoms emerge from pale pink buds.
